**3. SPECIFIC PROCEDURE**

In the event of overspray chemical exposed the following precautions and procedures will be put in place:

<b>ACTIONS</b>	<b>ROLE /RESPONSIBILITY</b>
➤ Parents and caregivers are notified as soon as possible after the incident has been reported via a range of communication mediums, email, text, phone call	Principal School Service officers
➤ The children will be moved away from the exposed area and taken indoors if required	Teacher
➤ The children's exposed skin will be washed with soap and water to remove any residual irritants ➤ First aid will be given if children show any negative affects to the exposure	School Staff
➤ Clothing worn by exposed children should be washed as per normal	Parent and caregiver
➤ The playground area, if applicable, should be hosed down to remove any residue that may remain on equipment and grass etc.	Principal Grounds Person
➤ Parents and caregivers are informed re follow up actions	Principal School Service officers
➤ Incident recorded in IRMS and appropriate personnel informed <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Educational Director</li> <li>○ Compliance officer of Biosecurity SA   Primary Industries and Regions SA - PIRSA</li> <li>○ Manager, Work Health &amp; Safety</li> </ul>	Principal
